TOUR THE KIPS BAY DECORATOR SHOW HOUSE

Earlier this week the 2013 Kips Bay Decorator Show House opened its stately doors to reveal a spectacular array of inspiring rooms by the country's top design talents. Now in its 41st year, the New York event has raised over \$17 million for the Kips Bay Boys & Girls Club, which supports after-school programs for the city's young people in need. Among the 18 hand-selected designers who helped transform this year's home—an Upper East Side townhouse—are the AD100 firm Gomez Associates, who created a subtle yet elegant sitting room inspired by founder Mariette Himes Gomez's London flat, and Million Dollar Decorators' reality-star Kathryn M. Ireland, whose exuberantly patterned traditional master suite stands apart from the largely contemporary spaces.
